General information:

We offer an Australian school immersion experience, where overseas children integrate fully into our classes and hear and see everything our students experience. Our Short-term International Students Program is designed to give overseas students a feel for what it is like to study in a Christian school in Australia, where the curriculum is taught from a Biblical worldview.

Please note that this program is only suitable for students who speak English at a conversational level. Students need to have a strong understanding of English as all classes are in English, and the program does not include ESL lessons. Parents are encouraged to seek outside school hours tuition in this area if they desire.

Students are to be on their best behaviour also, as they are representing their nation and their schools.

The school fees cover all classes, excursions and experiences during their stay with us. We do not offer ESL as part of this experience -

1. This program is only available in Term 3 (July/August) if there are vacancies in classes.
2. The students travel to Australia on a Tourist/Visitor visa and their parents provide medical insurance.
3. The parents or agents organise their homestay accommodation.
4. Homestay parents are responsible for transport to and from school.
5. Homestay parents are responsible for providing the students' morning tea and lunch either from home or through the canteen.
6. Short-term students participate fully in mainstream classes and are expected to take part in all of the College activities for the duration of their stay.
7. The minimum study period is four weeks; however, six to eight weeks is preferred for the benefit of the experience. **Please do not send through applications for students who cannot make a 4-week commitment.**
8. The cost per week is pro-rata of our International Students fees including Building Fund. The application fee of \$150 is paid in full for each student at the time of application.
9. Students receive a Certificate of Attendance and a simplified school report at the end of their experience.
10. Students are placed into age appropriate year levels; however, consideration of existing class sizes is taken into consideration.
11. To maintain the high uniform standard in the College, short-term students wear their school uniform from their own school, or opt to purchase and wear a full Brisbane Christian College uniform. The cost of uniforms is additional to school fees.

ENROLMENT PROCEDURE

The application will consist of:

- Application for enrolment form
- \$150 Application Fee (non-refundable)
- Passport.

Please ensure that all of the details requested on the application form are completed. The Letter of Offer cannot be issued without this information.

Enrolment Procedure:

1. Application documentation and \$150 Application Fee received
2. Acceptance by Head of School
3. Letter of Offer and invoice issued
4. Return of signed Letter of Offer and payment of invoice
5. Compulsory orientation session on the day before commencement.
