

Instrumental Music Teacher – Guitar (inc. Bass Guitar & Ukulele) and Drums

The College is seeking to appoint an Instrumental Music Tutor for Guitar (including Bass Guitar and Ukulele), a Tutor for Drums, or a combination of these to join our dedicated instrumental music teaching team. The ability to teach Orchestral Percussion would be considered an advantage.

Details are below:

- Guitar: approximately 1 – 2 days per week, depending on student enrolment and teaching areas. Days are currently Thursday and Friday but are flexible and may be negotiated.
- Drums teaching is approximately 1 day with possible opportunity to extend; flexible times
- Each position is a subcontracted role and involves teaching private music lessons only.

The successful applicant will:

- Hold a current Blue Card (Queensland's Working with Children Check) or be a teacher registered with QCT, have received two COVID-10 vaccinations and will be able to fully support the Christian ethos of the College.
- Have experience and qualifications to teach guitar/drums to an intermediate level
- Have a high level of skill, musical and technical knowledge
- Be able to inspire and motivate students at differing levels of ability and implement appropriate adjustments and differentiation where required
- Show willingness and ability to support the College's music events and activities
- Demonstrate ability to work collaboratively with leadership teams, other Instrumental Tutors and Primary and Secondary Music Teachers to ensure the smooth running of the program
- Demonstrate ability to communicate effectively with parents, students and other staff members
